Steiner's unique Diamond Marine lens coating is applied by using rare fluoride and minerals and guarantees unequalled light transmission, clarity and contrast. That gives you perfect and clear images, even in low light conditions.

The unsurpassed field of view has been optimized about 15% at 145 metres and offers the maximum view in every situation especially when it matters most and every second counts. The Sports-Auto-Focus system keeps images razor-sharp from 20 metres to infinity: once set, the Sports-Auto-Focus provides such quality without refocusing while looking at the object, even when distances are changing and as darkness falls. The 3-D brilliance gives you natural colour rendering, impressively vivid images and outstanding depth of field.

The 7x50 specification is ideal for use on water and ensures bright images, around the clock. Maximum light transmission is guaranteed by objective lenses with a 50 mm diameter. With 7x magnification, the Commander is easy to keep steady also in rough water and always provides blur-free images.



This new Commander series boasts the legendary Steiner ruggedness, making this model ideal for even the harshest marine conditions: the binoculars are manufactured using high-tech Makrolon housing that makes them both lightweight and rugged. The floating prism system uses a flexible elastic mount to protect the optical parts against shock and therefore maintains the precise adjustments through decades of impacts and abuse. A specialised sealing technology makes all binoculars of the Commander series waterproof down to 10 metres.

The pressurised nitrogen filling via the patented Steiner 2-way-valve-technology prevents from condensation inside the binoculars. Suitable for use in temperatures ranging anywhere from -40°C to +80°C, these binoculars offer trouble-free use even in arctic or tropical conditions. The proven hydrophobic coating – known as Steiner Nano-Protection® - creates a lens surface that reliably protects against dirt and water. Even rain and snow quickly form droplets that disappear from the field of view. The coating also enables easy cleaning of the lenses and ensures perfect clarity, all the time.

The ergonomic design and the proven Comfort-Balance-System guarantee comfortable and easy handling. The advanced NBR rubber armouring with Steiner's characteristic ribbing ensures a secure and slip-proof grip, thus the risk of dropping is no longer a worry. The Steiner ComfortGrip features specially-designed soft thumb pads that guarantee secure and worry-free viewing which is helpful especially during long periods of observation. The Memory Ocular allows the user to quickly find his own personal diopter setting: simply adjust to the individual diopter and mark it with the neon yellow arrow and within fractions of a second you can retrieve your setting. That way, this feature reduces unnecessary loss of time after conscious or unconscious adjustments by others, such as crew members, sharing your binoculars.

The eyecups are also ergonomically designed, allowing an optimised distance to the exit pupil and providing comfortable use of the entire XL field of view – even for those who wear glasses. They also protect the eyes from light and wind entering from the sides.

As a feature the new Commander 7x50 contains the most accurate high-end compass. This fail-safe navigational tool always ensures fast, precise and reliable bearings. The compass needle is able to react quickly thanks to sophisticated liquid dampening. Clever mirror-displaying of the degree value onto the bottom of the field of view guarantees a clear and unrestricted image. The optimised positioning of the on/off switch means you don't have to move your hand to switch the illumination on and off, leaving you with fast and easy handling without needing to let go. Supplementary, the compass is surrounded by the NBR long-life armouring, shielding it from damage of water or impacts. The integrated precision reticle provides accurate size and distance calculations and is an invaluable tool for estimating distances to targeted objects. The bearing line is so fine that it never interferes with the field of view. The battery compartment opens easily by turning, without the need for tools, so that the battery can be changed anywhere, anytime.

The binoculars come with a practical and functional case, a durable floating strap with reflective 3M luminous stripes, a soft neoprene carrying strap, objective lens covers and a protective rain cover.
